



The Historic North Loop

She was teaching art in South Carolina but remained in touch with some fellow students from New York. While living there, she had visited Stieglitz's gallery at 291 but had not yet met the famous photographer and gadfly of avant-garde art. She knew what he stood for, though, and had been excited by what she saw in the gallery: shows of such artists as Picasso and Braque, Rodin and Brancusi, Cézanne and Matisse, all of whose works had never been seen before in America. Also, she had read the magazine Stieglitz published, Camera Work, which included studies and reproductions of the most modern art from Europe and America.

On New Year's Day 1916, without consulting O'Keeffe, her friend Anita Pollitzer showed Stieglitz several of O'Keeffe's charcoal abstractions. He was impressed and delighted. "Those drawings—how I understand them," he wrote. "They are as if I saw a part of myself." They seemed direct, immediate, personal expressions in modern, abstract form, yet independent of influence from European "isms" such as Cubism or Fauvism. To him, they represented hope for a truly American idiom.

In May he exhibited some of them in a group show—O'Keeffe's first exhibition—at his gallery. By that summer the two had begun to correspond regularly, writing enthusiastically about art and their work. She was 29 years old and needed someone to recognize and nurture her nascent talent; he was 52 and had made it his mission to discover and foster modern American art.

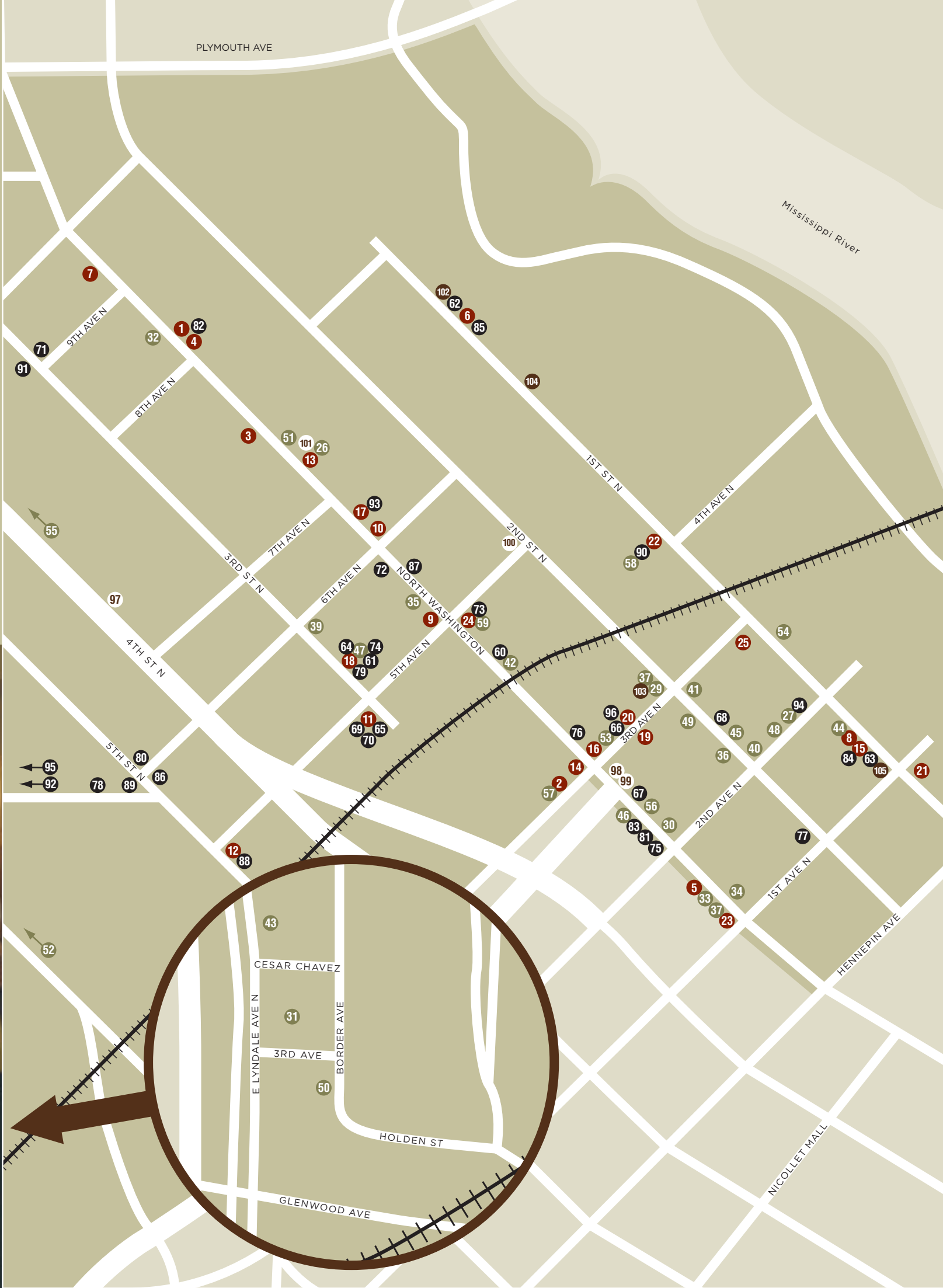
